August is currently in Los Angeles shooting *Without Apparent Motive* (working title) with Julianne Moore andRichard Gere. The reception will take place at the Writer's Guild Theatrein Beverly Hills, followed by a screening of Aki Kaurismaki's *The ManWithout a Past*, Finland'sforeign language Oscar submission that recently cleaned up at the Finnish JussiAwards.

This year's Scandinavian Film Festival is the thirdsequel to the successful LA showcase of Scandinavian films and film-makerslaunched in 2000. Each year, the festival pivots around the Scandinavian filmssubmitted for the foreign language Oscar category with additional screenings of short subjects and documentaries.
